SUBJECT: Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Consumption of the following Food Supplements:

- 1. PEARL WHITE SLIMMING CAPSULE**
- 2. VERIFIT SLIMMING CAPSULE FOOD SUPPLEMENT**
- 3. DIETWORKS HEALTHY WEIGHT MANAGEMENT APPLE CIDER WITH GINGER, CAYENNE & MAPLE MAXIMUM STRENGTH FORMULA**
- 4. FRUITS OF NATURE AVOCADO OIL PREMIUM DIETARY SUPPLEMENT**
- 5. KETO SCIENCE KETOGENIC MCT OIL**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public from purchasing and consuming the following food supplements:

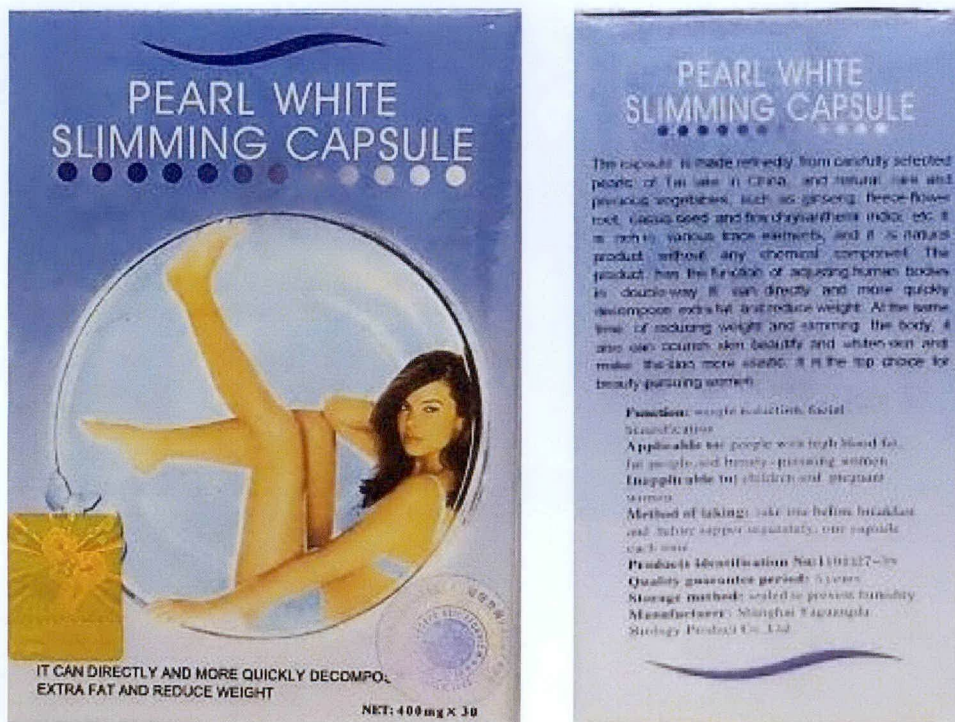


Figure 1. Unregistered Pearl White Slimming Capsule

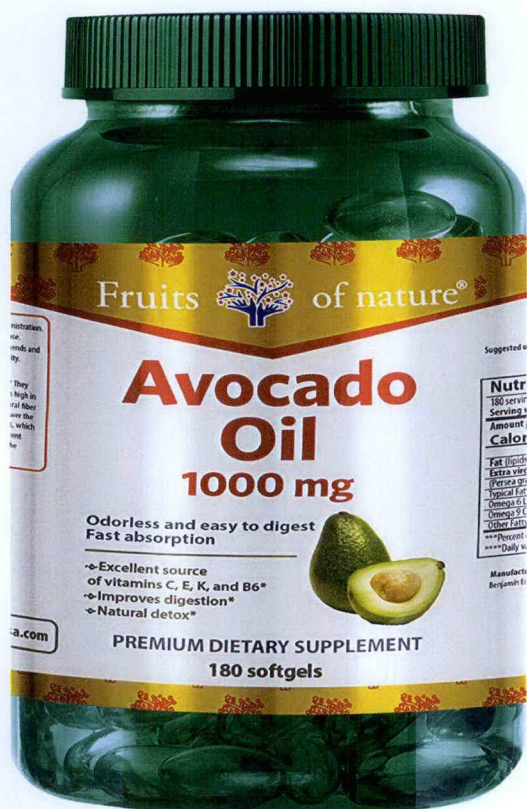


Figure 3. Unregistered Fruits of Nature Avocado Oil Premium Dietary Supplement (Source: Google image)

The FDA verified through post-marketing surveillance that the above mentioned food supplements are not authorized and the Certificates of Product Registration have not been issued. Pursuant to the Republic Act No. 9711, otherwise known as the "Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009", the manufacture, importation, exportation, sale, offering for sale, distribution, transfer, non-consumer use, promotion, advertising or sponsorship of health products without the proper authorization is prohibited.

Since these food supplements have not gone through evaluation process of the FDA, the agency cannot assure their quality and safety. The use of such violative products may pose health risks to consumers.

In light of the foregoing, the public is advised not to purchase the aforementioned violative products. Moreover, the public is advised to always check if a food supplement is registered with the FDA. The FDA website (www.fda.gov.ph) has a *Search* feature which may be used by typing in the name of the product before purchasing.


All concerned establishments are warned not to distribute violative food supplements until they have been issued the appropriate authorization, a License to Operate (LTO) for the establishment, and a CPR for the food supplement.

All FDA Regional Field Offices and Regulatory Enforcement Units, in coordination with law enforcement agencies and Local Government Units, are requested to ensure that violative products are not sold or made available in the market or areas of jurisdiction.
