SUBJECT: Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Use of Unregistered Household/Urban Pesticide (H/UP) GOLDEER GLUE MOUSE BOARD

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public from purchasing and using the unregistered household/urban pesticide (H/UP) product, **GOLDEER GLUE MOUSE BOARD**. (Refer to the image below)

- 老鼠通常沿着墙边在房间角落处出没，请将粘鼠板打开置于老鼠容易出没的通道或房间角落处。
- 老鼠沾到水时会降低粘性，请在粘鼠板底下垫上报纸以便提高粘捕率，必要时可固定在地面上，但应避免阳光直射或水浸入。
- 请勿放在灰尘飞扬和有油污的地方，以免降低粘性。
- 请勿让儿童及宠物碰到粘鼠板，当不小心粘到胶板时，请使用植物油清洗，再把胶板取下，然后用软性洗涤剂和水洗净。

- This product is non-toxic, harmless, strong viscosity and reusable. It is a much safer product substitute rat bait. Easy to use, no environmental pollution, can eliminate the rat harm to human and livestock.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Mouse always hang out in room corner, please place the stickboard to the aisle and room corner.
- When the mouse is wet, the glue mouse board is bad when mouse is wet. In order to improve the capture mouse, please put newspaper under the glue mouse board.
- Fix on the ground if necessary but remember to avoid from sun and water.
- To keep stickness avoid from the place with much dust and oil.
- Don't let children and pets touch the boardsack. When your hands appliance or other things adhere to the stick board. Take down the stickboard first then wash your hands and all things by vegetable oil.


In light of the foregoing, the public is advised not to purchase the aforementioned violative product. Moreover, the public is advised to always check if a household/urban pesticide product is registered with the FDA. The FDA website (www.fda.gov.ph) has a *Search* feature which may be used by typing in the name of the product before purchasing.

All concerned establishments are warned not to distribute violative household/urban pesticides until they have been issued the appropriate authorization, a License to Operate (LTO) for the establishment, and a Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) for the household/urban pesticides.

All FDA Regional Field Offices and Regulatory Enforcement Units, in coordination with law enforcement agencies and Local Government Units, are requested to ensure that violative products are not sold or made available in the market or areas of jurisdiction.
