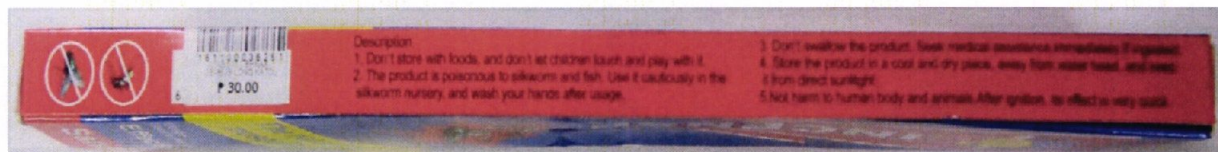
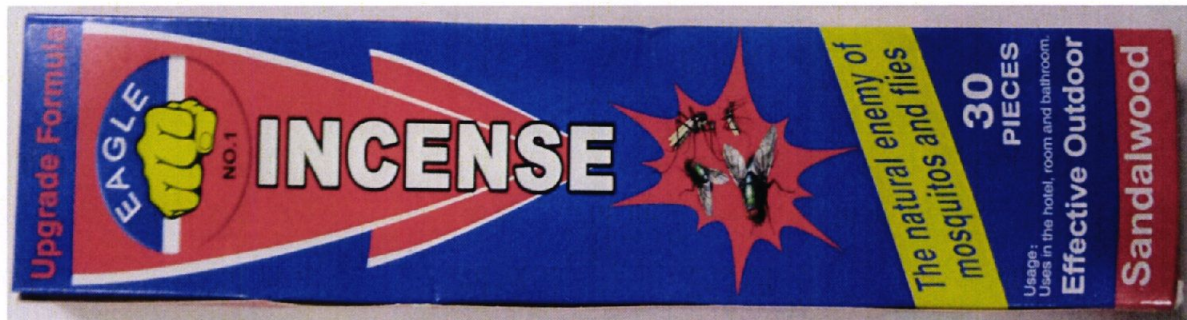

SUBJECT: Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Use of Unregistered Household/Urban Pesticides (H/UP) SANDALWOOD EAGLE INCENSE

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public from purchasing and using the unregistered household/urban pesticides (H/UP) product, **SANDALWOOD EAGLE INCENSE**. (Refer to the image below)



The abovementioned product was verified by FDA through postmarketing surveillance and shows no record of valid Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) as a form of authorization. Pursuant to Book II, Article I, Section 1 (a) of the Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act No. 9711, otherwise known as the “Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009”, the manufacture, importation, exportation, sale, offering for sale, distribution, transfer, non-consumer use, promotion, advertising, or sponsorship of any health product without the proper authorization from the FDA is prohibited.

Since the abovementioned unregistered household/urban pesticides product has not gone through the registration process of the FDA, the agency cannot assure their efficacy, quality and safety. The use of such violative product may pose health risks to consumers.
