The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) advises the public against the purchase and use of the verified counterfeit Losartan Potassium (Angel-50) 50mg Film Coated Tablet:

The FDA together with the Marketing Authorization Holder (MAH), Pharmakon Biotec Inc., have verified that the sample drug product is counterfeit.

The importation, selling or offering for sale of such is in direct violation of Republic Act No. 9711 or the Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009, and Republic Act No. 8203 or the Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs. Anyone found selling the said counterfeit drug product will be penalized.

All Local Government Units (LGUs) and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) are requested to ensure that this counterfeit product is not sold or made available in their localities or areas of jurisdiction.
