SUBJECT: Warning Against the Circulation of Forged Certifications (i.e. Waiver of Registration)

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public from the circulation of *forged* "Certifications" allegedly issued by FDA Officials:

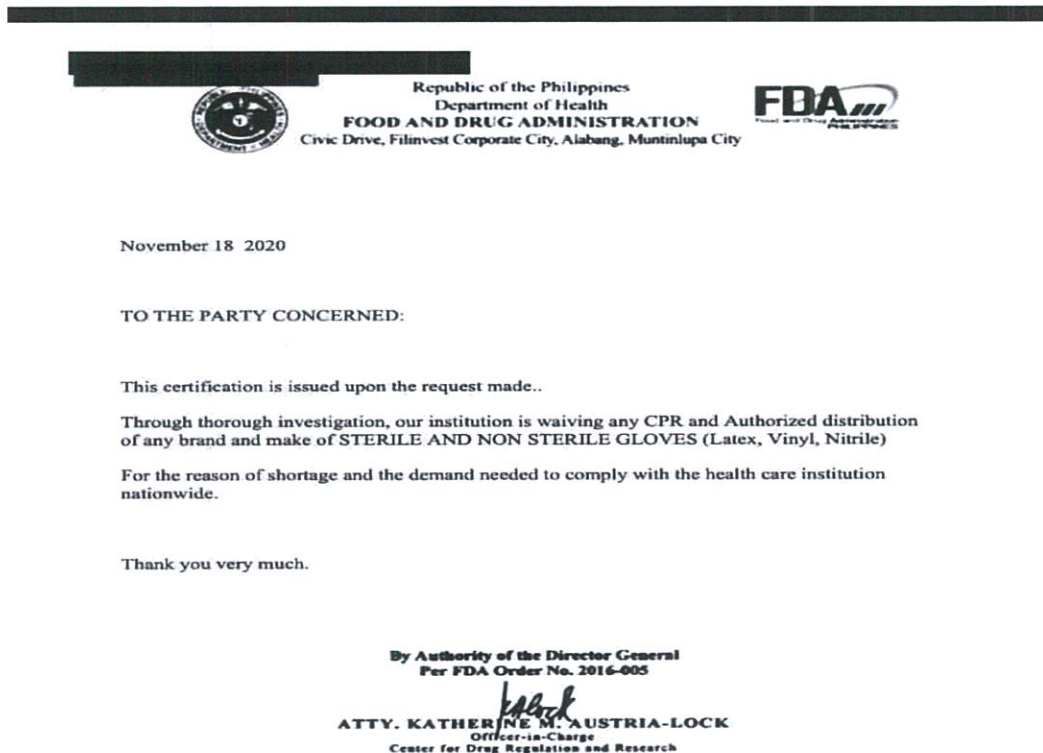


Figure 1. Certification of Waiver from CPR Registration



In light of the foregoing, the public is advised not to honor, use and/or accept any similar certifications until and unless issued through the official channels of the FDA. Moreover, the public is advised to always be vigilant as to the authenticity of FDA documents presented before them.

All concerned establishments are warned not to use or honor any similar documents included in this advisory until and unless they are verified as authentic before the FDA.

All FDA Regional Field Offices and Regulatory Enforcement Units, in coordination with law enforcement agencies and Local Government Units, are requested to ensure that these forged certifications are removed from circulation.
