<u>Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Consumption</u> of the following Unregistered Food Products:

1. STRIDE CANDY

2. GLASS BOTTLE WITH IMAGE OF GREEN MANGO

3. RICE-CRISP LIKE PRODUCT

4. <u>LUOSIFEN (PRODUCT NAME IN FOREIGN</u> CHARACTERS)

5. VACUUMED POUCH WITH BULL HEAD ARTWORK (BRAND NAME AND PRODUCT NAME IN FOREIGN CHARACTERS)

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns all healthcare professionals and the general public **NOT TO PURCHASE AND CONSUME** the following unregistered food products:
