SUBJECT : Postponement of the Deadlines
of A.O. 85 s. 1990

SECTION 1. Postponement of Starting Dates

In response to the request of the Pharmaceutical Industry, the starting dates for the use of the BFAD-approved labels and the declaration of products with old labels without remedial labels per A.O. 79 s. 1989, for products covered by A.O. 85 as misbranded are hereby postponed as follows:

1. Use of BFAD-Approved New Generic Labels in new production for multiple-active ingredient products under A.O. 85	June 30, 1990 (accurately, July 1, 1990)	Aug. 16, 1990
2. Old labels shall be deemed misbranded and subject to seizure	Sept. 30, 1990 (accurately, Oct. 1, 1990)	Nov. 16, 1990

SECTION 2. Effectivity

This A.O. shall take effect 15 days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
