In answer to queries on the classification of the products listed below, the Office of the Director issues this Bureau Circular for all those concerned. Please be advised that the classification of the following products are hereby stated:


- Oral Rehydration Salts - Household Remedy (ORS-90-Replacement) composition per liter of water - as per WHO recommendation
- Lagundi 300mg tablet - Household Remedy
- Multivitamins Oral formulations - Drug, Over-the-counter (with formulation found in PNDF 5th Edition Volume I)
