CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 218-2002

To:

All District/Port Collectors

And Others Concerned

Subject: Monitoring of Salt Importation

Attached is a letter from the Secretary, Department of Agriculture duly endorsed to the Commissioner of Customs by the Secretary of Finance, relative to the request of the DA for continued assistance in the monitoring of salt importation into the country, specifically inviting attention to the reiteration of instructions as contained in the BOC Memorandum Order dated August 21, 2000 as follows:

A BOC clearance is needed before imported salt could be released 1. from the port;

Imported food grade salt is tested if iodized. For non-iodized food-2. grade salt, importers should be required to indicate plan for iodization. For imported industrial salt, importers should be required to indicate their clients for monitoring purposes.

Continue to assist DOH in monitoring salt that enters the country by 3. providing quarterly report of entries, including names and addresses of

importers and quantity of shipment.

Following the joint NNC Governing Board and Salt Iodization Advisory Board meeting held last 13 March 2002, Agriculture Secretary Leonardo Q. Montemayor wrote Finance Secretary Isidro N. Camacho requesting for the assistance of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) in monitoring salt importation as stipulated in Section 8 Rule VI of RA 8172 to ensure that only iodized salt gain entry into the country.
