**TO : ALL FOOD DISTRIBUTORS/IMPORTERS, BUREAU OF
CUSTOMS, FDA PERSONNEL, AND OTHER CONCERNED**


**SUBJECT : NOTIFICATION OF REGISTERED IMPORTED WINES WITH
NEW VINTAGE**

Effective 25 September 2014, all distributors/importers can import wine using existing valid Certificate of Product Registration (CPR), hence no new application for registration is required, provided, that the wine is not reformulated and the only change in the product is/are the vintage, aroma, taste, and/or alcohol content.

For the purpose of validation and monitoring, all distributors/importers with new vintage are hereby directed to submit the following documents to FDA:

1. Notification letter from the company;
2. Notarized Affidavit of Undertaking that the changes on the label are only vintage year, aroma, taste, and/or alcohol content;
3. Label/s reflecting the only change on the label i.e. vintage and/or alcohol content;
