Job Description:

1. Evaluates and processes documents submitted in connection with the application for the issuance of authorization of a radiation facility and radiation devices
2. Provides assistance in the conduct of radiation protection survey and evaluation (RPSE)
3. Provides assistance in the development of policies, standards, regulations, and/or guidelines regarding radiation regulation
4. Provides assistance in the undertaking of research in radiation devices and technology.
5. Assists in providing technical/advisory service related to radiation technology work.
6. Performs other related functions as maybe assigned.

All qualified next-in-rank personnel shall be automatically considered candidates for promotion. For all interested FDA regular employees including the qualified next-in-rank candidates, they are required to submit item numbers 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7 listed hereunder, to the FDA-Human Resource Development Division (HRDD). Failure to do so shall be deemed a waiver of their right to be included as candidates for

the positions applied for. Further, please be advised that those employees with at least Very Satisfactory (VS) rating in the last two (2) Performance Rating periods shall be considered for promotion.

- 5. Diploma in any relevant Master's/ Bachelor's Degree and Transcript of Records;
- 6. Performance Rating for the last two (2) rating periods (for government employees);
- 7. Certificates of trainings attended, if any (in case of managerial/ supervisory trainings for the last 5 years); and
- 8. Latest Appointment and Service Record/Certificate of Employment. (FDA Job Order Personnel need not submit this document)

- 1. Applicants are advised to secure certified true copies/ authenticated copies of documents specified in item numbers 4, 5, and 6 the soonest time, in case of appointment to the position applied for.
- 2. Applicants are limited to apply up to two (2) vacant positions only.
