Meanwhile, we will be relocating FDAC very soon to Civic Prime Bldg., Civic Drive, Alabang, Muntinlupa City, a site almost just a stone's throw away from the present FDAC facilities at the FDA Main Office. Please expect the same, if not better level of service in the new facility as we prepare an even more modern FDAC for your convenience.

- 1.5 Central Services Laboratory (CSL)
- 1.6 FDA Academy
- 1.7 Records Releasing
- 1.8 Cashier
- 1.9 Telephone Operators
- 1.10Manager/Supervisor

- The usual services shall be provided to ensure smooth operations such as but not be limited to:
- 2.1 Receiving of applications for License to Operate (LTO), Certificate of Product Registration (CPR), other Authorizations and documents at FDAC;
- 2.2 Attending to walk-in clients;
- 2.3 Handling of complaints and inquiries at the Public Assistance and Complaints Desk;
- 2.4 Receiving the submission by the industry of compliance documents;
- 2.5 Receiving and encoding all documents arriving via courier;
- 2.6 Scheduling of appointment with the concerned Center/ Office.
