Public Health Warning Against Unregistered Food Supplements with their Unapproved and Misleading Advertisements and Promotion on Their Products:

1. GLUTATHIONE GRAPE SEED COLLAGEN, VIT C, VIT E FOOD SUPPLEMENT

2. <u>COLLAGEN PROTEIN SOFTGELS FOOD</u> SUPPLEMENT

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public against unregistered food supplements with therapeutic claims on their brochure:

GLUTATHIONE GRAPE SEED COLLAGEN, VIT C, VIT E Food Supplement Main Ingredients: Serv. Size: 2 Capsules, Amount Per Serving, Glutathione 100mg. Collagen 200mg, Grape Seed 50mg, Vitamin C 50mg Vitamin E 20mg Direction : once per day , two capsules per time Specification: 100 Veggie Capsules/bottle Health function: 1. provide superior whitening and anti aging benefits 2. contains super antioxidants to improve immune system plus the power of collagen for skin elasticity and bone regeneration. 3. detoxifies the body 4. improves mental function I. 


Figure 2. Sample Brochure of Unregistered Collagen Protein Softgels Food Supplement with Therapeutic Claims

The public is hereby warned that food supplements being advertised by VITAHWAY are not registered with the FDA. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 9711, otherwise known as the "Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009", the manufacture, importation, exportation, sale, offering for sale, distribution, transfer, non-consumer use, promotion, advertising or sponsorship of health products without the proper authorization from FDA is **prohibited**.

Likewise, all claims advertised by the said establishment are false, deceptive, and misleading. As per Administrative Order 2010-0008, no person shall advertise, promote, or use in any sponsorship any food/dietary supplements unless such product is duly registered and approved by the Food and Drug Adminisration.

Accordingly, since unregistered food supplements have not gone through evaluation and testing process of the FDA, the agency cannot guarantee their quality and safety. The consumption of such violative products may pose potential health hazards to the consuming public. Food products including food supplements should not bear any misleading, deceptive, and false claims in their labels and/or any promotional materials that will provide erroneous impression on products' character or identity.

In light of the above, the public is advised not to purchase the aforementioned violative products. Moreover, the public is advised to be vigilant against food products that might not be duly registered with FDA. Always check if a food product has been registered with FDA before purchasing it by making use of the embedded *Search* feature of the FDA website accessible at www.fda.gov.ph.
