RECALL OF SPAM CLASSIC and HORMEL FOOD BLACK-

LABEL LUNCHEON LOAF DUE TO POSSIBLE

CONTAMINATION

The public is advised to observe caution in the consumption of <u>Spam® Classic and Hormel</u> <u>Food Black-Label Luncheon Loaf</u> due to possible contamination.

Following consumer complaints, the United States - based company, Hormel Food Corporation, owner of the brand names of <u>Spam® Classic and Hormel Food Black-Label Luncheon Loaf</u>, commenced the recall of the said products in the United States due to the possibility that they contain pieces of metal that might cause injury to consumers.

The recalled products bear specific information which can be found under the bottom of the can (Please see attached Annex for your ready reference), and were distributed in mainland USA, and in Guam, USA.

Although the recalled products were distributed in the mainland USA and GUAM, USA only, the public is still advised to observe caution in their consumption as the foregoing products may have, by any means, reached the local market.








