Public Health Warning Against Unlicensed Establishment

"Pandora Equipment Specialist Corp.".

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) advises the public against purchasing products from the unlicensed company **Pandora Equipment Specialist Corp.** located at 1147 Isidro Mendoza St. Paco, Manila.

Following R.A. No. 3720, as amended by R.A. No. 9711, and pursuant to the Administrative Order 2016-0003, all establishment that imports and sell medical device shall secure appropriate License to Operate (LTO) from FDA prior to engaging such activities. The issuance of LTO is proof that the establishment is legitimate and complies with good distribution practices.

In view of these reports, the FDA warns the public against the purchasing from unauthorized distributors. Consumers availing products from these unauthorized distributors are at risk of buying counterfeit products.

To determine whether an establishment is licensed with the FDA, kindly validate with the FDA website. Just type in the name of the establishment in the search box (upper right corner).

The FDA has already initiated the conduct of investigation on the proliferation of medical devices being sold or offered for sale from unauthorized distributors.

All Local Government Units (LGUs) and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) are requested to ensure that products from this distributor are not sold or made available in their localities or areas of jurisdiction.
