**SUBJECT: Public Health Warning Against the Use of Unregistered Household Urban Pesticide (HUP) products of which Active Ingredients (AI) are Below the Declared Label Claim (Batch 9)**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public against the purchase and use of the following unregistered HUP products of which AI are below the declared label claims (refer to the attached annex for the product particulars/details):


1. **Strike Black Mosquito Coil Repellent** (previous Registration no. HSR-7081)
2. **Cobra Katol Mosquito Coil** (previous Registration no. HSR-5376)

These unregistered products were also found to be Out of Specification (OOS) based on laboratory testing. The samples collected by the agency as part of the Post Marketing Surveillance (PMS) showed laboratory test results of Strike Mosquito Coil repellent containing 0.0326% w/w of AI Esbiothrin which does not conform with the declared claim of 0.22% w/w of the AI. Likewise, Cobra Katol has 0.0685% w/w of Allethrin which is below the label claim of 0.2% w/w.

In light of the above, the public is advised not to purchase and use the aforementioned unregistered and violative products due to concerns in their bioefficacy to vector/pest control as well as their safety and quality. All concerned establishments are warned not to distribute the above-identified products. Moreover, all Local Government Units (LGUs) and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) are requested to ensure that the above-identified products are not sold or made available in their localities or areas of jurisdiction.



