**SUBJECT: UPDATES ON KOREAN NOODLES CONTAMINATED
WITH BENZOPYRENE**

Following the recent report from the Korean Authorities particularly the Korea Food and Drug Administration (KFDA) detection of Benzopyrene in instant noodles manufactured by Nong Shim Co. Ltd., and as agreed by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) licensed importers of the affected instant Korean Noodles manufactured by Nong Shim Co. Ltd. to conduct a voluntary recall of the subject products, the Department of Health-FDA (DOH-FDA) hereby issues the list of identified Korean Noodles to be voluntary recalled from the market, thus:
