SUBJECT: Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Use of the following Violative Cosmetic Products as Reported in the ASEAN Post-Marketing Alert System (PMAS)

- 1. VIA LETVASS EYE SHADOW PALETTE**
- 2. PETIC LIPSTICK WITH VITAMIN E & ALOE VERA**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) warns the public from purchasing and using the following violative cosmetic products which tested positive for the presence of **RHODAMINE B** as reported in the ASEAN Post-Marketing Alert System (PMAS). This ingredient is not allowed to be part of a cosmetic product as per ASEAN Cosmetic Directive (ACD). The table below indicates the particulars of the violative cosmetic products:

The aforementioned cosmetic products have been tested by the Myanmar, Department of Food and Drug Administration, as part of their post-marketing surveillance activities and results of the laboratory analyses show that the aforementioned products are not compliant with the technical standards set forth by the ACD.


In light of the foregoing, the public is advised not to purchase the aforementioned violative cosmetic products. Always check if a product is notified with the FDA by using the FDA Verification Portal feature accessible at <https://verification.fda.gov.ph> which may be used by typing in the name of the product before the purchase and/or using the cosmetic products.

All concerned establishments are warned not to distribute violative cosmetic products.

All FDA Regional Field Offices and Regulatory Enforcement Units, in coordination with law enforcement agencies and Local Government Units, are requested to ensure that violative products are not sold or made available in the market or areas of their jurisdiction.
