Special Provision(s)

- 1. Value-Added Tax Collected from Marsa Races. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, Twenty Nine Million Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (P29,420,000) shall be used for the following purposes sourced from Value-Added Tax collected on conduct of horse races by the Manila Jockey Club, Inc. (MJCI) and Philippine Racing Commission, Inc. (PHILRACOM) in accordance with Section 6 of R.A. No. 6631 and Section 8 of R.A. No. 6632, respectively, and implemented by DOF-BBM J.C. No. 2008-1 dated June 16, 2008:
 - a) Twenty-four percent (24%) of the collections from MJCI and PMILRACOM to augment the operating requirements of the Philippine Anti-Tuberculosis Society;
 - b) Eight percent (8%) of the collections from MJCI and PHILRACON to augment the operating requirements of the White Cross, Inc.; and
 - c) Twenty-eight percent (28%) of the collections from PHILRACOM to augment the operating requirements of the PCSD.
- Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.C. No. 292, s. 1987.

The DDM shall submit to the DBM, the Nouse Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on financial and physical accomplishments. The Secretary of Health and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the DDM website.

2. Hospital Income. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, all income generated from the operation of specialized hospitals, medical centers, institute for disease prevention and control, including drug abuse treatment and rehabilitation centers and facilities, blood service facilities, national reference laboratories and other hospitals under the DON shall be deposited in an authorized government depository bank and used to augment the hospital's MODE and Capital Outlays including payment of PNILNEALTH premium under the Point of Care Program: PROVIDED, That, at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the said income shall be utilized to purchase and upgrade hospital equipment used directly in the delivery of health services.

In no case shall said amount be used for the payment of salaries, allowances and other benefits.

Disbursements or expenditures by the hospitals in violation of the above requirement shall be void and shall subject the erring officials and employees to disciplinary actions in accordance with Section 43, Chapter 5 and Section 80, Chapter 7, Book VI of E.G. No. 292, and to appropriate criminal action under existing penal laws.

The DON shall prepare and submit to the DBM not later than November 15 of the preceding year, the annual operating budget for the current year covering said income and the corresponding expenditures. Likewise, it shall submit to the DBM not later than March i of the current year its audited financial statements for the immediately preceding year. The Secretary of Health and the Agency's meb administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that the foregoing documents are likewise posted on the DOM mebsite.

3. Fees and Charges of the Dureau of Quarantine and International Health Surveillance. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, Minety Eight Million Seven Mundred Fifty Five Thousand Pesos (P98,755,000) shall be used for the operational requirements of the Bureau of Quarantine and International Realth Surveillance sourced from fifty percent (50%) of the fees and charges collected in accordance with Section 9 of R.A. No. 9271.

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.O. No. 292, s. 1987.

The BQIHS shall submit to the DBM, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on financial and physical accomplishments. The Director of BQIHS and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the DOM website.

4. Fees, Fines, Royalties and Other Charges of the Food and Drug Administration. In addition to the amounts appropriated berein, Two Hundred Forty Eight Million Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (P248,270,000) shall be used in support of its Five-Year Devolopmental Plan sourced from fees, fines, royalties and other charges collected by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in accordance with N.A. No. 9502

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.O. Mo. 292. The FDA shall submit to the DBM, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by may of electronic document, separate quarterly reports on financial and physical accomplishments. The Administrator of the FDA and the Agency's meb administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the FDA mebsite.

5. Quick Response Fund. The amount of five Hundred Ten Million five Hundred Thousand Pesus (P510,500,000) appropriated herein for the Quick Response Fund (QRF) shall serve as a stand-by fund to be used for the rehabilitation and repair of health facilities, replacement of medical equipment, as well as provision for emergency medical assistance, including pre-positioning of medical aids in order that the situation and living conditions of people in communities or areas stricken by calamities, upidemics, crises, and catastrophes which occurred in the last quarter of the immediately preceding year and those occurring during the current year may be normalized as quickly as possible. In no case shall the QRF be used for pre-disaster activities or any other purpose not authorized in this provision.

The DOM shall submit to the DBM, the National Bisaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the status of the utilization of the QRF. The Secretary of Health and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the DOM medsite.

- 6. Mealth Facilities Enhancement Program. The amount of Twenty Six Billion Eight Hundred Seventy Two Million Three Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Pesos (P26,872,368,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the implementation of the Mealth Facilities Enhancement Program, composed of:
 - a) Eighteen Billion Nine Nundred Sixty One Million Three Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Pesos (P18,961,396,000) for the construction, upgrading, expansion, rehabilitation and repair of, barangay health stations, rural health units, public/LGU hospitals, specialized hospitals, regional medical centers, dangerous drug abuse treatment and rehabilitation centers and other health care facilities, with priority given to those located or mearby areas where there are large number of poor families or households under the National Nousehold Targeting System for Poverty Reduction (NNYS-PR) or where there are no private health care facilities which can provide affordable and quality health care: PROVIDED, That the amount of Three Billion Four Nundred Forty Six Million Six Hundred Thirty Ymo Thousand Pesos (P3,446,632,000) appropriated herein for the construction, upgrading and expansion of LGU Health Care Facilities shall be released directly to the Department of Public Morks and Highways (DPNN): PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the BPNN

shall implement the construction, upgrading, and expansion of LGU Health Care Facilities following the DOM licensure requirement: PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, That the DPWH shall construct LGU Health Care Facilities only in lots that are already owned or acquired by the government: PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, That Health Facilities Enhancement Projects initially implemented by Local Government Units (LGUs) may be delegated by the DPWH to the said LGUs through the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement: PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, That the amount of Fifteen Billion Five Hundred Fourteen Million Seven Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Pesos (PL5,514,764,400) appropriated herein for the construction, upgrading, expansion, repair and rehabilitation of barangay health stations, rural health units, public/LGU bospitals, specialized hospitals, regional medical centers, dangerous drug abuse treatment and rehabilitation centers and other Bealth Care Facilities shall be implemented by the DOH through public bidding in accordance with R.A. No. 9184 and its implementing rules and regulations (IRR): PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, That the DPMH and DOB shall be allowed to deduct not more than Zero Point Five Percent (0.5%) of the total project cost of each project as administrative overhead expense: PROVIDED, FURALLY, That the administrative overhead expense shall not be authorized for infrastructure projects costing One Million Pesos (P1,000,000) and below; and

b) Seven Billion Kine Hundred Ten Million Nine Hundred Seventy Two
equipment for government health care facilities to be constructed,
equipment in bulk to ensure cost efficiency, subject to compliance with R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR, and pertinent auditing laws,
roles and regulations.

The details of the Mealth Facilities Enhancement Program are provided in Volume II-B of this Act.

The Secretary of Health and the Agency's meb administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that the list, distribution and cost of government health care facilities constructed, upgraded, expanded, rehabilitated and repaired and hospital equipment purchased under the Health Facilities Enhancement Program are posted on the BON mebsite.

7. Project Modification. The Secretary of Mealth is authorized to change the barangay health stations, rural health units, public/LGU hospitals and other health care facilities to be constructed, upgraded, expanded, rehabilitated or repaired or equipment to be purchased within each of the activity under the Mealth Facilities Enhancement Program, subject to the following: (i) the allotment released has not been obligated; (ii) may only be done once and until June 30, 2016, except if due to the occurrence of calamities; (iii) of the same project category; (iv) within the same legislative district; and (v) undertaken by the same operating unit.

In no case shall change in operating unit be allowed.

The BOH shall inform the DBM, copy furnished the House Committee on Appropriations, and the Senate Committee on Finance, in writing, of every modification within five (5) calendar days from its approval. The Secretary of Realth and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that such modification is likewise posted on the DOH website within the same period.

- 8. National Health Insurance Program for the Indigents and Senior Citizens. The amount of Forty Three Billion Eight Numbered Thirty Five Million Seven Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Pesos (P43,835,766,000) appropriated herein shall be used for subsidy of health insurance premiums of indigents and senior citizens composed of:
 - a) Thirty Seven Billion Sixty Million Four Bundred Forty Thousand Pesos (P37,060,440,000) for health insurance premiums of indigents;
 - b) Six Billion Seven Hundred Seventy Five Million Three Hundred Twenty Six Thomsand Pesos (P6,775,326,000) for health insurance premiums of the semior citizens which are not yet covered by any PRILHEALTH Insurance Program and are not qualified as dependents of principal newbers.

PROVIDED. That not more than seven percent (7%) of the foregoing amounts shall be used for administrative expenses.

The PMILHEALTH accredited health service providers shall have a profile of each enrollee in a database linked to the PMILHEALTH through an automated information skaring system. The PMILHEALTH shall likewise identify those senior citizens who may be entitled either as principal members or qualified dependents based on their health conditions. The DOM and PMILHEALTH skall ensure the conduct of third-party impact evaluation study and validation of the actuarial valuation of the Mational Realth Insurance Program.

Release of funds to PMILHEALTH shall be made through the BTr.

The PRILHEAITH shall submit to the DBM, the Bouse Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, by way of electronic document, the proof of availment by each indigent or cognizance of eligibility and benefits, together with a summary report. The President of PHILMEALTH and the Corporation's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said information are likewise posted on the PHILMEALTH website.

9. Assistance to Indigent Patients. The amount of Two Billion Seven Hundred Eighty Three Million Three Hundred Forty Five Thousand Pesos (P2,783,345,000) appropriated herein under the Assistance to Indigent Patients shall be used for hospitalization and assistance to indigent and poor patients: PROVIDED, That not more than one percent (1%) of said amount shall be used for administrative expenses.

The DOB shall submit to the DOM, the Mouse Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the utilization of funds. The DOH and recipient government bospital shall post on its website the following: (i) name of recipient government bospitals and indigent patients, whether confined or out patients; and (ii) types of medical assistance or services and/or drugs and medicines given. The heads of agencies and web administrator or their equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said information are posted on the agencies' websites.

10. Preventive Health Care Programs. The amounts appropriated herein under Disease Prevention and Control and Mational Pharmaceutical Policy Development shall be used exclusively to implement preventive health care programs.

11. Pinoy NO Scholarship Program. The amount appropriated herein for the Pinoy NO Scholarship Program shall be used to provide scholarships to applicants who passed the medical entrance examination of any DOH-partner school and complied with the criteria set forth by the DOH, with priority given to poor and deserving students or those coming from families belonging to the low-income bracket as determined by the PSA-MSCB. The DOH shall develop a database that will effectively provide periodic monitoring of the Program's scholars.

The DOR shall submit to the DBM, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the utilization of funds. The Secretary of Health and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the DOH website.

12. Bottom-Up Mudgeting Projects. The amount of Five Hundred Sixty Five Hillion Three Hundred Four Thomsand Pesos (P565,304,000) appropriated under: (i) Environmental and Occupational Health; (ii) Family Health and Responsible Parenting; (iii) Health Emergency Management; (iv) Implementation of Doctors to the Barrios; (v) Other Infectious Disease (HIY/AIDS, Dengue); (vi) Mational Pharmaceutical Policy Development; and (vii) Implementation of Various Projects for LGUs shall be used for the Bottom-Up Budgeting (Bub) Projects. LGUs that will implement Bu8 Projects shall be limited to those that have complied with the requirements of Good Financial Mousekeeping under the Seal of Good Local Governance and LGU Public Financial Management Improvement Program pursuant to DBH-DILG-DSMD-MAPC JMC No. 5 dated October 1, 2014 and such other criteria as may be provided in the guidelines.

The DOH shall submit to the DBM, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, quarterly reports on the financial and physical accomplishments of BuB Projects. The Secretary of Mealth and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible in ensuring that said reports are likewise posted through the OpenBuB Portal.

13. PAyapa at MAsaganang PamayaMan Program. The amount of Fifty Three Million Five Mundred Sixty Six Thousand Pesos (P53,566,000) appropriated herein for the Payapa at Masaganang PamayaMan Program shall be used exclusively to implement projects in conflict-affected areas already identified by OPAPP.

Release of funds to PMILKEALTH shall be made through the BTr.

The PMILHEALTH, shall submit to the OPAPP, either in printed form or by way of electronic decement, quarterly reports on the status of implementation of the PANAMA Program, including the list of beneficiaries. The President of PMILHEALTH and the Corporation's web administrator or bis/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the PRILHEALTH mebsite.

14. Purchase and Allocation of Drugs, Medicines and Vaccines. The amount of Eight Billion Mine Bundred Fifty Four Million Four Mundred Fourteen Thousand Pesos (P8,954,414,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the procurement of drugs, medicines and vaccines, including medical and dental supplies for distribution to government health care facilities: PROVIDED, That eighty percent (80%) of said amount shall be allocated to provinces where: (i) there are large number of poor families or households under the MNTS-PR; and (ii) the absolute number of poor and the incidence of poverty are high as identified in the latest official poverty statistics of the FSA-MSCD: PROVIDED, FURTHER. That bulk procurement of centrally procured drugs, medicines and vaccines, including medical or dental supplies, equipment and instruments may also be allowed.

The amount of drugs, medicines and vaccines purchased by PMILMEALTH cardholders in DOM hospitals shall be reimbursed by the PMILMEALTH to the DOM. The amount reimbursed shall them be used exclusively by the DOM for the construction of additional health care facilities, including the purchase and upgrade of hospital equipment. In no case shall said amount be used for the payment of salaries and other allowances.

The DOH shall submit to the DDM, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, quarterly reports on the utilization of funds. The Secretary of Health and the Agency's meb administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the DOM mebsite.

- 15. Advance Payment for Drugs and Vaccines Not Locally Available. The DON is authorized to deposit or pay in advance the amount necessary for the procurement of drugs and vaccines, not locally available, from the World Health Organization, the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund, and the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) EmbN and other United Nations
- 16. Deployment of Medical Norkers. In the deployment of doctors, midwives, nurses and other medical workers, the DOM shall give priority to localities where the absolute number of poor and the incidence of poverty are high as identified in the latest official poverty statistics of the PSA-NSCB.
- 17. Allocation for Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao from Matienally Funded Projects. The DOM shall ensure that the allocation for ARMM shall be released directly to ARMM-DOM, through the Office of the Regional Governor, based on the submission by the DOM of the allocation, per province in the ARMM, copy furnished said provinces.

The Secretary of Health and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that the amounts allocated for ARMM per province are posted on the DOM website.

The ARGMM shall likewise submit to the DBM and BBM, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the utilization of funds, per province in the ARMM. The Regional Governor of ARGMM and Regional Government's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensering that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the ARGMM website.

18. Appropriations for Programs and Specific Activities. The amounts appropriated herein for the programs of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities in the indicated amounts and conditions:
