**INVITATION TO BID FOR
SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LABORATORY
SUPPLIES FOR DAVAO TESTING AND QUALITY
ASSURANCE LABORATORY (DTQAL)**

1. The *Food and Drug Administration*, through the SAGF 2022 intends to apply the sum of **2,529,530.00** being the ABC to payments under the contract for ***Supply and Delivery of Laboratory Supplies for Davao Testing and Quality Assurance Laboratory (DTQAL)***. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The *Food and Drug Administration* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required by *Thirty (30) Calendar Days after receipt of the Notice of Award/Notice to Proceed*. Bidders should have completed, within *Five (5) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "*pass/fail*" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - a. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from *Food and Drug Administration* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during **8:00AM-5:00PM**.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **19 - 26 July 2022** from the given address and website below, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **P5,000.00**. The *Food and Drug Administration* shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees thru bank transfer.
