- 5. Provides technical assistance related to licensing and registration based on the standards and existing rules and regulations set by FDA.
- 6. Performs other related functions as maybe assigned.

- 8. Latest Appointment and Service Record/Certificate of Employment. (FDA Job Order Personnel need not submit this document)
