**SUBJECT : Public Health Warning Against the Purchase and Use of the Unregistered Drug Product "Dr. Manila Crocodile Scar Removal Serum 1.35 fl. oz/ 30 mL"**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) advises the public against the purchase and use of the unregistered drug product:

**Dr. Manila Crocodile Scar Removal Serum**

Scar removal  
Anti-inflammatory treatment  
Dark spot treatment  
Smooth the irregularity
