ANNEX A Inspection of PCO Establishment

- A. During inspection, the PCO establishment shall be required to present the following documents:
 - 1. Organizational Chart of the PCO Establishment
 - 2. 201 File of Technical Personnel (including Job Description)
 - 3. Signed Duties and Responsibilities of SPH, PH, and other Personnel
 - For SPH handling multiple branch offices of the PCO Establishment, such shall be so stated in his/her duties and responsibilities, the identified branch offices and his/her supervisory functions on such.
 - 4. Risk Management Plan
 - 5. Safety Training Plan for SPH, PH, and other personnel
 - 6. Training Certificates of SPH, PH, and other personnel
 - 7. Contract Agreement with DOH-accredited health facility that will conduct the annual medical check-up of its personnel
 - 8. Medical/Health Certificates of SPH, PH, and other personnel
 - 9. Documents relating to the Schedule and Conduct of PCO activities
 - 10. Documents relating to the procurement of FDA-registered Household/Urban Pesticides (HUPs) and other non-pesticide products under the jurisdiction of the FDA
 - 11. Documents relating to inventory of FDA-registered HUPs and other non-pesticide products under the jurisdiction of the FDA, equipment, and other materials
 - 12. Safety Data Sheets of FDA-registered HUPs and other non-pesticide products under the jurisdiction of the FDA for Use
 - 13. Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) on the following, including but not limited to:
 - · Conduct of PCO activities
 - Conduct of supervision of pest control activities (including supervision of pest control activities of multiple branch offices, if applicable)
 - Conduct of additional activities during pest control (e.g., application of disinfectants)
 - Training of Technical Personnel
 - Handling, transport, application, storage, and disposal of FDA-registered HUPs and other non-pesticide products under the jurisdiction of the FDA
 - Handling, cleaning, calibration, and/or maintenance of application equipment, vehicle, PPEs, and other materials
 - Handling of complaints
 - Emergency response
 - Record-keeping and proper documentation
 - Other SOPs related to routine conduct of PCO activities
 - 14. Other Contract Agreements, if applicable
 - 15. Environmental Clearance, if applicable
- B. Other parameters for inspection shall include compliance to specific conditions and requirements set forth in this Circular, and in applicable standards, rules, and regulations.
