## **Job Description:**

- 1. Evaluates and processes documents submitted in connection with the application for the issuance of authorization of a radiation facility;
- 2. Participates in the development of policies, standards and/or regulations guidelines regarding radiation regulation;
- 3. Evaluates quality assurance programs, shielding designs and calculations of radiation facilities;
- 4. Conducts radiation protection survey and evaluation and compliance monitoring of radiation facilities and devices;
- 5. Evaluates personnel radiation dose and facility radiation monitoring reports;
- 6. Provides technical assistance or advisory services to stakeholders regarding ionizing and non-ionizing radiation devices and facilities;

- 7. Undertakes research in radiation devices and technology; and
- 8. Performs other related functions as may be assigned.

All qualified next-in-rank personnel shall be automatically considered candidates for promotion. For all interested FDA regular employees including the qualified next-in-rank candidates, they are required to submit item numbers 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7 listed hereunder, to the FDA-Human Resource Development Division (HRDD). Failure to do so shall be deemed a waiver of their right to be included as candidates for the positions applied for. Further, please be advised that those employees with at least Very Satisfactory (VS) rating in the last two (2) Performance Rating periods shall be considered for promotion.

Any Proof of eligibility (Report of Rating/License/Certificate of Eligibility/Eligibility Card (photocopy, scanned copy, or site/screen capture of the eligibility using the Civil Service Eligibility Verification System [CSEVS], Professional Regulation Commission's [PRC]'s Licensure Examination and Registration Information System [LERIS], or Supreme Court of the Philippines [SC] Lawyer's List or other sites as may be applicable);
- 4. Copy of valid NBI Clearance
- 5. Photocopy of Diploma in any relevant Bachelor's Degree/Masters of Law/Bachelors Degree of Law and Transcript of Records (TOR);
- 6. Latest Performance Rating available (applicable for government employees only);
- 7. Certificates of trainings attended
- 8. Latest copy of Appointment Paper, Service Record and Certificate of Employment. (FDA employees and Contract of Service (COS) personnel are not required to submit this document)
