SUBJECT: Repealing of FDA Circular No. 2014-022 “Notification of Registered Imported Wines with New Vintage”, and FDA Circular No. 2016-007 “Notification of Sources for Raw Materials, Low Risk, Medium Risk and High Risk Prepackaged Processed Food Products

This is to announce that FDA Circular 2020-033 B repealed the following Circulars:

1. FDA Circular No. 2014-022 entitled “*Notification of Registered Imported Wines with New Vintage*”, and
2. FDA Circular No. 2016-007 entitled “*Notification of Sources for Raw Materials, Low Risk, Medium Risk and High Risk Prepackaged Processed Food Products*”

Hence, all Food Business Operators (FBOs) are no longer required to submit notification letters to the CFRR. However, all FBOs shall comply with the following:

- For imported wines with new vintage – shall apply for amendment under “change in product name”
- For notification of sources for raw materials, low risk, medium risk and high risk prepackaged processed food products – shall include the sources documents in the registration application

For more clarity, these above mentioned steps and requirements are specified in the FDA Circular 2020-033.
