The Supplier may identify its subcontractor during the contract implementation stage. Subcontractors identified during the bidding may be changed during the implementation of this Contract. Subcontractors must submit the documentary requirements under Section 23.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 and comply with the eligibility criteria specified in ITB Clause 5 to the implementing or end-user unit.</b></p>

The Supplier will be responsible for the acts, defaults, and negligence of any subcontractor, its agents, servants, or workmen as fully as if these were the Supplier’s own acts, defaults, or negligence, or those of its agents, servants, or workmen.</b></p> <p><i>Note: Bidder shall provide a Memorandum of Agreement with its subcontracting partner.</i></p>
